Declaring the City's Onan™, Cummins 6A3.4-powered Standby Generator and Automatic Load Transfer Switch from the Former Temporary Police Station Surplus, and Authorizing the City Manager to Dispose of Said Equipment

RECOMMENDED MOTION

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Sausalito Declaring the City's Onan™, Cummins 6A3.4-powered Standby Generator and Automatic Load Transfer Switch from the Former Temporary Police Station Surplus, and Authorizing the City Manager to Dispose of Said Equipment

SUMMARY:

The City's Onan™, Cummins 6A3.4-powered Standby Generator and Automatic Load Transfer Switch from the Former Temporary Police Station, is no longer needed at that site and would require an estimated \$6,000 in electrical repairs (were the transfer switch to be needed) and \$15,000 in air pollution control equipment to comply with current regulations (see estimates from Cummins West attached). Staff recommends that the equipment be declared surplus and disposed of through auction with the proceeds to be added to the City's Capital Equipment Replacement Fund. Staff does not at this point in time plan to replace the equipment. Section 37350 of the Government Code of the State of California provides that, "(a) City may purchase, lease, receive, hold and enjoy real and personal property, and control and dispose of it for the common benefit."

ISSUES

None identified.

FISCAL IMPACT

A relatively small credit to the City's Capital Equipment Replacement Fund is anticipated – between \$3,000 and \$12,000.







**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAUSALITO
DECLARING THE CITY'S ONAN™, CUMMINS 6A3.4-POWERED STANDBY
GENERATOR AND AUTOMATIC LOAD TRANSFER SWITCH FROM THE
FORMER TEMPORARY POLICE STATION SURPLUS, AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SAID EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Sausalito is the owner of certain personal property described in detail as: "Onan™, Cummins 6A3.4-powered Standby Generator and Automatic Load Transfer Switch Engine Serial Number 53128484" (the "Equipment"); and

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Public Works finds that, at this time, owing to its age, its service condition, and existing as well as anticipated air pollution regulations that there is no present or prospective reasonable use for said Equipment in the delivery of the City's services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sausalito derives the authority to dispose of said Equipment under California Government Code Section 37350; and

WHEREAS, the City may responsibly accomplish such disposition by contracting for the services of a duly-licensed and legally-operated auction company rather than utilizing Staff with other more pressing duties; and

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Public Works has determined that replacement of the Equipment is not necessary at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sausalito:

1. The City Council of the City of Sausalito declares the Equipment described hereinabove as Surplus and authorizes the City Manager to dispose of said property with all proceeds from disposition being credited to the Capital Equipment Replacement Fund.

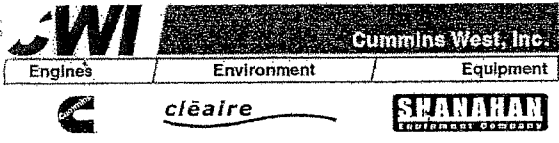
