ANALYSIS

Effective December 7, 2010, state law mandates that an additional \$3.00 surcharge be added to every parking citation issued by the City for a parking offense with an associated penalty, fine or forfeiture. This money is then distributed to the County Treasurer for deposit in the Trial Court Trust Fund as provide in SB 857.

Staff has prepared the attached resolution which updates the Master Fee Schedule regarding fees as described above (see Attachment for draft resolution).

FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of the proposed increase in parking citation fees will allow the City to fully cover its mandated obligation to the County and the State with no revenue loss.



**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAUSALITO, CALIFORNIA
