Informational Only – Annual Listing of all Vacancies Occurring on Boards/Commissions during 2011

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Receive and file annual Boards/Commissions vacancy list pursuant to the Maddy Appointive List Act

SUMMARY and BACKGROUND

The Maddy Appointive List Act (the "Maddy Act") was enacted in order to generate maximum public awareness of appointments to be made by the Governor, the City Council, or other legislative bodies (G.C. 54970). The purpose was to take into consideration a vast and largely untapped reservoir of talent which exists among the citizenry that all too frequently is not aware of the opportunities for participation on local regulatory and advisory boards and commissions.

In accordance with this provision, on or before December 31st of each year, a list of appointments of all ongoing boards, commission and committees that are appointed by the City Council must be prepared and posted. This list must include which terms will expire during the next calendar year, with the name of the incumbent appointee, the date of appointment, the date the term expires, and the necessary qualifications for the position.

Accordingly, the attached list was prepared and posted outside the Sausalito Public Library on the City's public notice bulletin board on December 15, 2010.

This item has been brought before Council as informational only. No action is required. Staff presents the list of 2011 vacancies so that Council is also aware of the vacancies that will occur on the various boards and commissions, and when interview schedules may be required.
