RE: Live Oak located at 1 San Carlos Ave

On Monday, November 1, 2010, I inspected the 35-inch in diameter at breast height Live Oak (*Quercus agrifolia*) located at the corner of 1 San Carlos Ave and Harrison Ave.

The tree has a thin canopy of leaves and several decayed branches. The trunk has large pockets of decay and, on its base the tree shows advanced symptoms of Phytophthora sudden oak death (i.e. oozing and horizontal cracks).

This Live Oak hangs over San Carlos Ave and Harrison Ave and it leans over the garage of 1 San Carlos Ave. Also, there are high voltage wires that go through the upper canopy of the tree.

Due to the health condition of the tree and considering its location on the landscape, this tree represents an imminent hazard and should be removed as soon as possible.
